

Nancy Tatem Scholarship fund

The Nancy Tatem Scholarship Fund has been set up as a memorial to Nancy who was an adult day director in Doylestown and died May 1998. This money has been earmarked for educational purposes. Therefore, it can be used for staff who wish to participate in the medication training class or other in-services.

A scholarship fund application for reimbursement is enclosed in this newsletter. Please review the following guidelines.

Fund Committee

1. Will consist of three members appointed by the PADSAs Board of Directors
2. Will meet or phone conference in June and November to consider scholarship applications and will make a report to the board following those meetings

Utilization Criteria- The fund may be used by individuals for:

1. Adult Day Service Program Assistant Training/Testing
2. DPW/ Dept. of Aging approved medication administration course
3. PADSAs Regional Workshops for ADS Staff, with priority given to those on the S.E. region
4. PADSAs State Conference, with priority given to those from the S.E. Region
5. PADSAs sponsored or approved trainings or conference.
6. Master Trainer's Course for the program assistant certification or medication administration training programs
7. Special requests will be considered for non-PADSAs courses or training with prior recommendation of the committee and PADSAs Executive Committee

Eligibility Criteria- Who may apply for scholarships:

1. Individuals (Staff or Administrators) working in Adult Day Services for 6 months or longer.
2. PADSAs members or their staff persons will be given priority preference
3. Priority will be given to individuals working in free-standing ADS Centers

General Guidelines

1. The Committee may give a maximum of six scholarships per year
2. No more than ½ the fund will be used in 1 fiscal year
3. The cost of the educational program will be reimbursed to the scholarship applicant upon successful completion of the course, program, or conference

5. A maximum of \$75.00 per person per year will be granted
6. A limit of one scholarship per center per year will be granted
